Please see information following from Mons Bernard which is shared from the Parish newsletter:

On Pentecost Sunday of this year Bishop Stephen invited every parish community in the diocese to enter prayerfully into a process he called "R_e_s_h_a_p_i_n_g__O_u_r__F_u_t_u_r_e"_In his pastoral letter he reminded us that the Holy Spirit is always doing something new in the Church, calling us to renew our mission and to respond with faith and courage to the needs of today's world.

Bishop Steve specifically identified six parishes in our region (by and large contained within the Tāmaki electorate) to discern how best we journey into the future. For our two parishes of St Heliers and Glendowie, this request to begin now takes concrete form. I am inviting you to begin a process of discernment with me as we reflect on our vision for the future, the dreams we have for ourselves and future generations and the mission we are called to.

We will hold our **first parish meeting** to begin this process of 'reshaping' on Sunday, November 23 from 2pm-4pm (time to be confirmed) at Glendowie School Hall, Riddell Rd, Glendowie. This is just a beginning of the journey!

It will be an opportunity for parishioners of both St Ignatius, St Heliers and Mother of Perpetual Help, Glendowie.
